APPROVED AIRPLANE FLIGHT MANUAL REVISION REQUIREMENTS

EFFECTIVITY: BEECHCRAFT Duchess 76, serials ME-1 through ME-6 and ME-8 through ME-182.

To revise the normal starting procedures by adding preflight checks to detect a loss of REASON:

electrical power and to provide an emergency procedure to be used in case of a complete

loss of electrical power in flight.

Beech Aircraft Corporation considers this to be a mandatory change and the P/N 105-COMPLIANCE:

590000-5A1 revision, dated March 1979, must be incorporated in the P/N 105-590000-5 Pilot's Operating Handbook and FAA Approved Airplane Flight Manual before the next flight of the airplane. An FAA Airworthiness Directive is forthcoming on this subject.

These Service Instructions and the P/N 105-590000-5A1 revision, dated March 1979, supplement Safety Communique 76-49 and supersede and cancel Addenda I and II to the Duchess 76 Pilot's Operating Handbook and FAA Approved Airplane Flight Manual, P/N 105-590000-5.
